"Foster" stools will be adopted out to the highest bidder on an annual basis during the adoption auction. Winning bidders will have custody for 10 months, in which the *adopted stools must be returned home for the holidays by November 1*st of the following year at The Forge. All adopting homes must complete a little paperwork after the auction to ensure the orphan stools are well taken care of by their adopters.

Mandatory Participation Dates

Races will be held annually on the **Saturday following St. Patrick's Day**, unless it falls on a Saturday, then it is the day of. Annual **Hog Festival Parade** (Fourth Saturday in October), possibly other **parades** as well as demonstrations upon request (B.W.B.P.S. reserves the right to arbitrarily alter the Mandatory Participation Dates with in some instances, short notice.).
